EMERGENCY ROOM

Open 24 hours a day.



IMMEDIATE CARE

Open every day, 8 am to 8 pm.



PRIMARY CARE

Open weekdays, 8 am to 5 pm.



WHEN TO GO

When the situation requires rapid or advanced care that is only available in a hospital setting.

Go to SkyCare Immediate Care if you have a medical problem that can't wait, but it's not an emergency. To maintain or improve your overall health. Your primary care team is your partner in wellness.

WHY TO GO Go for life-threatening emergencies such as severe injury, loss of consciousness, chest pain, or difficulty breathing.

Go for common conditions such as minor cuts, minor injuries, sprains, fever, cough, and earaches. Go for ongoing care, wellness checks, regular vaccinations, and chronic disease management.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Emergency Rooms see patients according to the seriousness of their conditions. You may have to wait.
